## Registration For Free Primary Education

No 77

The Federal Minister of Education, the Hon. Aja Nwachuku has authorized Mr. P. I. Awajomoba, Chief Education Officer, Lagos, to carry out a registration of persons of primary school age under the Section 14 of the Education (Lagos) Ordinance 1957 within the Federal Territory of Lagos.

1. The Registration of children for entry into Class I Infants in January 1959, under the Free Primary Education Scheme will take place from 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and from 4.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. on 25th & 26th and 27th August, 1958. There are 62 Centres at which children could be registered. The list of Centres and all maintained Schools under the scheme will be shown in an advertisement which will appear in 'The Press' a week before registration begins.

2. Parents resident in Lagos should take their children who were born in 1953, together with the children's Birth Certificates to the Centres for the schools of their choice on the dates specified.

3. Persons failing to register for Free Primary Education at the proper time will not be entitled to any consideration for places for their children in January 1959 except where they can show that though resident in Lagos in January, 1957 they were not so resident at the time of registration.

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
IS YOUR RADIO LICENSED???

In order to remove any misunderstanding that is likely to arise, it is necessary to inform all owners of wireless receiving sets that it is an offence under the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance (Cap 133) and the Regulations made thereunder for any person to use a radio unless he is in possession of a current Broadcast Listener's Licence.

Regulation 3 of the Wireless Telegraphy Regulations states as follows:

(1) The following fees shall be payable for each year or portion thereof during which any licence is in force but licences issued on or after the first day of July in any year shall be chargeable with only half these rates:-

Class A-	
(i)	Private residence . . . . . 10s
(ii)	Cafes, restaurants, hotels, and clubs . . . . . 2s
(iii)	Public entertainments, e.g. public halls, blackops, etc., open to the public on payment of a charge . . . . . £20
(iv)	For other premises or in special circumstances not less than the Director of Post & Telegraphs may prescribe.

The fee for a Broadcast Listener's Licence is 10/- and the Licences expire on the 31st day of December of each year and are renewable at any Post Office.

**Electricity Corporation  
of Nigeria  
Public Notice  
Method of Premises For A  
Supply Of Electricity.**

Persons who are engaged in the construction having their premises wired for electricity by the public electricity supply system, are advised that, with effect from their wiring installation, they should use the Electricity Corporation's supply system. The Corporation's supply system has been extended to all areas of Lagos State and Regulation 207 of the Electricity Supply Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 207 are as follows:

"207. (1) For the purpose of ensuring that the requirements of the Electricity Supply Regulations, and the provisions of the Electrical Wiring Regulations are being complied with, the Electricity Corporation of Nigeria shall require every consumer and/or prospective consumer to secure upon the Corporation's supply system.

"(2) The consumer's intention to connect or have installed electrical wires, wiring, fittings, apparatus and appliances on his premises.

"(3) That the consumer's intention to connect or have made any electrical or wiring installations on his premises shall be subject to the approval of the Electricity Corporation of Nigeria which shall exercise the necessary facilities for inspecting such premises, such electrical wires, fittings, apparatus and appliances and the progress of the work and on completion.

"(4) It is the duty of every consumer, for compliance with Regulation 207 of the Electricity Regulations, to point out that such wiring and electrical work is not locally necessary but is to the mutual benefit of the consumer and of the Corporation.
